



Bird Boards

The Steps

- Choose a bird and a room.
- Jot down your thoughts regarding the colors you see, the balance of colors, any patterns you're drawn to and the overall feeling you're getting from the photo.
- Jot down the items that you have (or imagine to have) in that room.
- Start searching for photos of furniture and other objects using the colors and patterns from the bird photo. Keep them organized in a folder on your desktop.
- Start pulling them into a simple mood board maker and then, if you like, create a collage type board.
